Venue

The gates to Goodwood circuit (MR 197/880074) will be opened at 07.00 hrs.

A service area vehicle pass is enclosed for one service vehicle. This must be displayed in the vehicle windscreen. No other vehicles will be allowed to pass through the tunnel. Any additional vehicles should be parked in the trailer car park.

Amendments, Corrections and Additions to SRs

10.9

In the event of any stage having to be stopped before all competitors have attempted it whether for reasons of time restraint or any other cause R24.5 will apply.

11. Awards

For the purpose of the awards a Novice Crew is defined by a crew who has competed on no more than three Stage Rallies.

Awards will be presented as soon as possible after the results are declared final in the Jackie Stewart Pavilion.

14. Venue & Service area

A speed limit of 15mph applies to all service roads and paddock area on site.

On arrival inside the circuit you will find the service area has covered 'stalls'. Competitors may have one each with the service vehicle adjacent to the stall. Marshals will be on hand to assist. Tyre warming anywhere in the venue is not allowed.

Litter bins are provided, please make sure that they are used. Please note that all generators must be placed on/housed in suitable trays/containers to prevent any oil or fuel spillage.

14.3 All servicing must be carried out on a non-porous sheet which exceeds the size of the car.

14.6 It is a condition of the circuit that no fires, barbecues or naked flames are permitted in the service area.

16. Modifications to General Regulations

R24.4.6 Red flags **WILL BE USED** with locations notified in the roadbook.

Scrutineering

Once in your stall the **scrutineer will come to you.**

A current MSA Vehicle Log Book must be produced.

Competition numbers should be in place before scrutineering and are not available on the day.

Please help speed up the scrutineering process by having helmets and overalls and log books ready for inspection.

Signing On

You will be required to produce:

A valid competition licence(Stage Rally National B or above for drivers, any National B or above for navigators)

Valid Club Membership Cards for the organizing clubs or any invited club.

You will then be issued with all paperwork necessary to compete on the event.

Competitors will be required to affix the organizers' rally plates before being allowed to start. These should be affixed to each door above the competition number

Process sheets

Crews may sign on before completing their process sheets but rallypacks/roadbooks will only be issued on receipt of fully completed sheets.

Noise Test

Noise tests will commence at 7.45am

Please go to noise test after scrutineering as process sheets will be issued by the scrutineer. Please be sure that your car WILL pass the noise test throughout the day. The circuit will monitor noise levels constantly and have the power to stop the event for up to half an hour if those levels are exceeded as well as excluding the culprit. If this happens it will result in everyone losing stage mileage.

Reminder:

A warm engine is more likely to pass the noise check than a stone cold one.

ALL CARS MUST BE ABLE TO PASS THE GOODWOOD NOISE TEST OF 105DB AT 3/4 MAX REVS

Cars will also be subject to a drive-by test with a maximum level of 101db
